- Students find the past participles in the text and list them with their infinitive forms.
- Ask students to say which verbs are regular and which are irregular. You could ask them to say the past simple forms as well as the participles.

- Look at the example with the class. Note that here the present perfect verb refers not to an achievement, but to a recent event. Here again, the event is in the past but we're seeing it in terms of its effect on the present. (*My watch has stopped – it isn't working now.*)
 - You may want to go through the whole exercise with the class and then ask them to write the answers. Tell them to use contracted forms with pronouns.
 - Note that there is further work on comprehension and practice of the present perfect in the Module 4 Review at the end of Unit 8.
